
Report to the Los Angeles City Ethics Commission on violations of the revolving door ordinance by Marie Rumsey



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#### 1 The Law

- 1. Section 49.5.2.A of the Los Angeles Municipal Code states that:
  - A. "Agency" means the City of Los Angeles or any City department, bureau, office, board, commission, or entity required to adopt a conflict of interests code subject to City Council approval. With respect to employees of a City Council member's staff and employees of the Chief Legislative Analyst's office, "agency" means the City Council.
- 2. Section 49.5.13.C of the Los Angeles Municipal Code states that:

The following time-based restrictions on lobbying activities apply to former City officials.

- 1. For one year after leaving City service, a City official shall not receive compensation to attempt to influence, either personally or through an agent, City action on any matter pending before any agency on behalf of a person other than an agency if, during the 24 months preceding the official's departure from City service, the official held any of the following positions: ... Council Aide VII.
- 2. For one year after leaving City service, all other former City officials shall not receive compensation to attempt to influence, either personally or through an agent, City action on any matter pending before an agency in which the City official served during the 24 months preceding the official's departure from City service on behalf of a person other than an agency. Serving an agency means being directly employed by or being assigned or on loan to that agency.

#### 2 The Facts

- 3. According to current Council District 13 field deputy Dan Halden, Marie Rumsey was employed by Council District 13 as a Council Aide VII through December, 2014. See Appendix 1 (p.3).
- 4. Marie Rumsey submitted a speaker card at the Los Angeles City Council Meeting on June 16, 2015 to speak on Council File 14-1656 on homeless people's property. This card identified her as a representative of the Central City Association. See Appendix 2 (p.5).
- 5. Marie Rumsey spoke at a meeting held by the Los Angeles Chief Legislative Analyst on June 25, 2015 for the purpose of gathering public opinion on Council File 13-1493 on street vending. At that time she stated that she was representing the Central City Association and the Downtown Center Business Improvement District. A transcription of her remarks can be found in Appendix 3 (p.7).
- 6. Marie Rumsey submitted a speaker card at the City Council's Economic Development Committee meeting on October 27, 2015 to speak on Council File 13-1493 on street vending. This card identified her as a representative of the Central City Association. See Appendix 4 (p.9).

7. Throughout 2015 Marie Rumsey was employed as a registered lobbyist by the Central City Association. See Appendices 5 and 6 (pp.11, 13).

## 3 Conclusions

- 8. On at least three occasions in 2015 within a year of being employed as a Council Aide VII (see paragraph 3), Marie Rumsey attempted to influence City action on at least two pending Council files (see paragraphs 4, 5, and 6 above), and was compensated for these efforts by the Central City Association (see paragraph 7). These actions constitute violations of §49.5.13.C.1 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code.
- 9. The agency Ms. Rumsey attempted to influence on these three occasions was the City Council, an agency for which she had served in the 24 months preceding her actions. Thus these actions also constitute violations of §49.5.13.C.2 of the LAMC.

Ms. Rumsey's comments begin at 49:38

Hi, good evening, my name is Marie Rumsey and I'm here on behalf of the Central City Association and the Downtown Center Business Improvement District. CCA represents approximately 350 businesses and the Downtown Center BID represents approximately 1700 property owners, and together we are proud members of the Coalition to Save Small Business. At the last community meeting on June  $18^{th}$ , the office of the Chief Legislative Analyst presented three models regarding a sidewalk vending program. Model one maintains the status quo while increasing enforcement, penalties, and fines. Model two is based on the City Council adopting a sidewalk vending program. Model three is community-driven and asks community members to develop a sidewalk vending program. None of these models take into account the broad policy considerations to establish a sidewalk vending program. We recommend that the City review the existing special sidewalk vending program and determine what works and what does not work. Communities should be able to opt out of the sidewalk vending district if they choose to do so, and communities should be able to determine how many vendors are appropriate for their neighborhood. There should also be a mechanism to determine what kind of goods are sold and protections for local businesses. Existing brick-and-mortar establishments should have the ability to approve if a vendor can set up in front of their business and vendors must have liability insurance to indemnify property owners. These components, along with enforcement, are essential to a successful sidewalk vending program. Thank you very much.


