1 Synopsis

1. The Central City Association of Los Angeles failed to timely amend its 2017 registration form. Its former employee, registered lobbyist John Howland, failed to disclose all City agencies he lobbied in Q1 2017. It's possible that these omissions, in addition to violating the Municipal Lobbying Ordinance, may have influenced the outcome of the Skid Row Neighborhood Council formation election on April 6, 2017.

2 Background

- 2. In December 2016 the Skid Row Neighborhood Council Formation Committee ("SRNC-FC") applied to the Los Angeles City Department of Neighborhood Empowerment ("DONE") for the formation of a Skid Row Neighborhood Council ("SRNC").
- 3. At the time that the SRNC-FC applied to form the SRNC, online voting was not allowed in neighborhood council elections. Persons opposed to the SRNC formation effort supported online voting in the SRNC formation election.
- 4. An election was held by DONE on April 6, 2017. The final vote tally was 824 against SRNC formation to 764 in favor of formation.
- 5. DONE is overseen by the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners ("BONC").
- 6. The Central City Association of Los Angeles ("CCALA") is a lobbyist employer registered with the City Ethics Commission in 2017. John Howland is a lobbyist registered with the City Ethics Commission in 2017. He was employed by CCALA from January 1, 2017 through March 31, 2017. Joanne Danganan is a lobbyist registered with the City Ethics Commission in 2017. She has been employed by CCALA at least since January 1, 2017.

3 Facts

- 7. The Los Angeles City Council has been deliberating over whether to allow online voting in neighborhood council elections ("online voting") since about November 2016. The associated Council File is CF 15-1022-S2.
- 8. At a meeting on March 20, 2017 BONC heard testimony and comments on online voting with the intention of recommending a course of action to the Rules and Elections Committee. John Howland commented at this meeting in favor of online voting. He identified himself as speaking on behalf of CCALA. Audio of the meeting is available from DONE and is also available on Archive.Org. His speaker card from this meeting is Exhibit 1 on page 7.²

- 9. Joanne Danganan spoke in favor of online voting on March 22, 2017 at a meeting of the Rules and Elections Committee. She identified herself as speaking on behalf of CCALA. Her speaker card from this meeting is Exhibit 2 on page 9.
- 10. On March 24, 2017 City Council adopted a report from the Rules and Elections Committee allowing online voting for the SRNC election only. See Exhibit 3 on page 11.
- 11. On April 24, 2017, CCALA filed its third amended registration form with CEC. This form did not mention the SRNC as an issue that CCALA was lobbying on. See Exhibit 4 on page 13.
- 12. On April 28, 2017, CCALA filed its fourth amended registration form with CEC. This form did mention the SRNC as an issue that CCALA was lobbying on. See Exhibit 5 on page 16.
- 13. On May 1, 2017 John Howland filed his first quarterly report for 2017. He listed neither BONC nor DONE among the agencies he lobbied. See Exhibit 6 on page 19.

4 Conclusions

- 14. The decision to allow online voting in the SRNC formation election is municipal legislation as defined in the MLO.
- 15. CCALA lobbied in favor of online voting, and therefore against SRNC formation, beginning no later than March 20, 2017.
- 16. CCALA's anti-SRNC lobbying effort was coordinated enough to involve more than one lobbyist, which suggests that their work on the issue began even earlier than March 20, 2017.
- 17. CCALA was bound by law to amend their annual registration form no later than March 30, 2017. They did not amend it until more than four weeks later.
- 18. John Howland was bound by law to disclose the fact on his first quarterly report that he lobbied BONC during Q1 2017. He did not disclose this fact.

5 Why these violations are more consequential than they may at first appear

19. The SRNC formation election was held on April 6, 2017. Since the SRNC formation failed by only 60 votes, it would only have been necessary for 31 voters (out of 1,590 people who voted) to change their minds or 61 new pro-formation voters (out of tens of thousands eligible) to decide to vote in order for the outcome of the election to be changed. If CCALA had disclosed its involvement in a timely manner it would have allowed SRNC proponents at least one week to use the information in the election

campaign. It's not implausible, therefore, that CCALA's violation of the law changed the outcome of the formation election.
