I don't know if you know this, but [REDACTED] runs a website called [michaelkohlhaas.org](http://michaelkohlhaas.org). He blogs under a pseudonym there and has being doing it for years. He has been using the public records act to obtain information from the city and the local business improvement districts and then writes articles, a lot of which are very misogynist, about what he finds. The City of Los Angeles literally has a person whose sole job is to respond to his requests and he has even gone as far as to ask for the pictures of the people who handle his request.

I suggest that you spend a lot of time looking at his website and read past articles. After the Skid Row Neighborhood Council elections people posted his article with a face crossed off on the door of one of my fellow neighborhood council people. Certain people are now scared to walk out of their office because of what he has written.

I wanted to give you a heads up. Right now someone who feels, rightly so, that [REDACTED] has wronged her has collected all of the worst things he has ever written. She is planning on taking this to the LA Times and LA Weekly that a [REDACTED] is using public request acts to publish mysoginist articles.
