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GIVE A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED:																											

The offense occurred in Washington, D.C. on Monday, May 27, 2019. At approximately 1700 hours until approximately 2000 hours, a large group of All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV) riders were observed illegally operating ATV's on public space, throughout the District of Columbia. On May 27, 2019, multiple calls for service, throughout the District of Columbia were received by the Office of Unified Communications. The calls for service were placed in regards to the large group of ATV's being operated, causing a public nuisance, impeding the flow of traffic and placing the motorists and pedestrians in harm's way. During this period of time your Affiant was able to obtain photographs for the group of riders as they illegally operated their ATV's and dirt bike on public space, throughout the district of Columbia.

Your Affiant viewed the photographs and assigned each individual suspect a number for organizational purposes. Subject #9 is described as a black male with a medium complexion [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Subject #9 was photographed operating a predominantly [REDACTED] ATV with a [REDACTED] attached to the front of the ATV. Subject #9 was photographed at approximately 1800 hours as fueled the aforementioned ATV and exited from the Exxon Gas Station at Benning Rd and Oklahoma Ave NE, after fueling the aforementioned ATV. Subject #9 departed the gas station parking lot onto Oklahoma Ave NE and turned right onto Benning Rd NE and traveled in an eastbound direction. A few moments later, additional Photographs of Subject #9 were obtained in the 3300 block of Benning Rd NE at the Shell Gas Station. At approximately 1812 hours Subject #9 was photographed in or near the 3300 block of East Capitol St NE as he operated the aforementioned ~~subject~~ **ATV #9** in an eastbound direction.

Additionally at 1700 hours, Officer Favero obtained video and photographs of Subject #9 as a large group of ATVs and dirt bike were in the 1400 block of Pennsylvania Ave NW, where several Go-Go bands were performing. At this time Subject #11 was operating the aforementioned dirt bike and was also photographed operating a predominately [REDACTED] ATV while doing "wheelies".

Upon reviewing the photographs, your Affiant recognized Subject #9 [REDACTED] with a date of birth of [REDACTED]. Your Affiant has had direct contact with Defendant [REDACTED]. Additionally, your Affiant has previously investigated and obtained an arrest warrants for Defendant [REDACTED] for Operating a Non Traditional Motor Vehicle on Public Space, which occurred on June 25, 2017 (CCN: 17110139), August 19, 2018 (CCN: 18138249) and on March 24, 2019 (CCN: 19049697).

Based upon the aforementioned facts, your Affiant believes that probable cause exists, and respectfully requests that an arrest warrant be issued for [REDACTED] with the date of birth of [REDACTED].
